Who can be married at Iffley Church?

The policy at Iffley church is to follow the Marriage Measure 2008. What this means is detailed below.

YOU CAN BE MARRIED AT IFFLEY CHURCH IF

ONE OF THE PERSONS WANTING TO BE MARRIED:

- Currently lives in the parish of Iffley; or
- · Is currently on the electoral roll of Iffley church; or
- Was baptised at Iffley church; or
- Has been confirmed and the confirmation entered in a church register book belonging to Iffley church (this would have been done on the basis that the person concerned was prepared for confirmation from Iffley church); or
- Has at any time had his or her usual place of residence in the parish of Iffley for at least 6 months; or
- Has at any time habitually attended public worship at Iffley church for at least 6 months;

OR ONE OF THE PERSON'S PARENT HAS AT ANY TIME DURING THE PERSON'S LIFETIME:

- Had his or her usual place of residence in the parish of Iffley for at least 6 months; or
- · Habitually attended public worship at Iffley church for at least 6 months

OR ONE OF THE PERSON'S PARENT OR GRANDPARENT

was married at Iffley church.

DOCUMENTARY EVIDENCE OF THE ABOVE

Will need to be provided at the time of booking your wedding at Iffley church.

HOWEVER

There may be exceptional reasons why you wish to be married at Iffley church which are not covered by the above list and in which case please contact the vicar.
